Obviously there doesn't seem to be anybody who has not experienced something like this at the JC: sitting at the desk of the Job Center official and he/she really turns you down. Instead of the wanted agreement to an education programm or a permission to move you leave the office with an integration arrangement in which you agreed to an application training. Nothing is solved. The often used rough talk some persons can handle easily, others feel intimidated. Our wishes and demands are seldom answered the way we would like to. Complaining afterwards is often not effective at all - "That ain't true, it was different", it sounds from the side of Jobcenter. Without independent witnesses you don't have good chances at the meeting at the Job Center.

That doesn't need to be like this!

Everyone has the right to bring in some persons to the meeting at the Job Center. And most often the presence of independent witnesses is sufficient to prevent Job Center employees from a rude tone and let them hang on to fair-play.
